Cut away stabilizer
 2 panels burlap, 7 x 16"
 Wash N Gone, 5 by 6" - Optional
 Fabric for Appliqué - 3.5" by 4"
 Ribbon

Step-by-Step shots are on the following pages.



Step 1. Hoop Cut Away Stabilizer in a 8 by 14" hoop. Stitch out placement stitch. *Helpful tip:* Using pencil and ruler extend the line outside of the placement This will help you to align the fabric.



Step 2. Fold fabric 2.25" down and press, then fold under again at 1/4". Press into place using iron. Your fold will need to be face out.



Step 3. Align top of folded material with the pencil marks (if you have drawn pencil marks) or the top of your pattern. Secured into place using spray adhesive or painters tape. Fold is face out.



Step 4. Place hoop into machine and run tack down stitch.



Step 5. OPTIONAL IF USING BURLAP. Once complete, pull hoop out of machine. Adhere panel of Wash-N-Gone over fabric panel.



Step 6. Place hoop into machine. Embroider ornaments and frame, then placement stitch for appliqué. Pull hoop out of machine adhere fabric to placement stitch with painters tape. Put hoop back into machine and run tack down stitch.

Step 7. Once stitched. Pull hoop out of machine and trim away excess material as shown. Put hoop back into machine.



Step 8. Embroider Seasons Greetings, ornament and flourish along with pearl satin stitch and button holes.

Step9. Pull hoop out of machine and place second panel of fabric, folded side face down. (And, again, fold fabric 2.25", press, then fold under again at 1/4". Press using iron.) Align the top folded edges together. Return hoop to machine.



Step 10. Run final tack down stitch. This stitch is a zig zag stitch to keep material from fraying.



Step 13. Pull bag out of hoop, trim away excess material as shown. Then reach into bag and pull bag right side out. Poke out corners gently to square off bag at the bottom. At this point, if you have used Wash-N-Gone gently remove excess from the bag.
